

Cape Town reports that the Lab had a great April which is a good achievement given all the public holidays thrown into the mix. They have now completed all feature film for TV productions mostly shot on 16mm and mostly intended for the German market. Also finished is Free Willy 4 while an ongoing project The Philanthropist for NBC is still in production. On the commercial side business is quietening down a lot, compared to the figures from last year. More local commercials were processed last year but international commercials were considerably less.

Johannesburg has acquired feature and documentary work for this period, however the commercial work through the bath has decreased slightly from last month. The commercials submitted by Media Host have shown a very slight decrease from last month which tends to follow the film laboratories trend.

We would like to thank the laboratories and Media Host for the information they have supplied to us. We make no attempt to identify the title of the production, or the production house or any other information as this is often confidential information – we

simply supply the numbers.
